# MINISTRIES

Throughout the week you will divide your time between training, leadership development, mission and church based-ministry. At application we ask you to specify which area of ministry you would be interested in serving in throughout the year.

We can offer internships in the following ministries or any suitable combination:

- Worship & Prayer
- Mission & Outreach
- Youth Ministry
- Children's Ministry
- Student Work
- Creative Arts
- Work with Older People

If there is another ministry area not on the list that you are interested in, just ask.





# TRAINING

As part of your internship we want to invest in you through:

## Leadership Development

- This will come in part from working with your ministry leader; having personal and group time looking at leadership styles; and exercising leadership in your ministry area, all with appropriate support.



**Theological Equipping** – You will have access to a number of the training courses that we run throughout the year. Various people will deliver a number of topics, including: Theology and Practice, Biblical Studies and Church History. This will be accompanied by a combination of group supervisions and personal assignments, all aimed to feed head, heart and life.

**Mentoring and Personal Development** - You will be assigned a mentor outside of the staff team to help support your development.

**Mission Opportunities** - At regular points during your year with us, you will be involved in mission and evangelism initiatives.

# PRACTICALITIES

## How much does it cost?

As an intern you are a volunteer, not an employee. We won't charge you anything, in fact food and accommodation will be provided. You will need to have additional income or savings to support yourself for the year, for personal expenses.

## Where will I live?

You will live with a family from St John's. This would be arranged for you after your application has been approved.



## Will I be able to work?

To get the most out of your year's internship it is best if you can avoid having to have a part time job. However, we want to be flexible and if you think it will be necessary for you to work then please talk to us.
