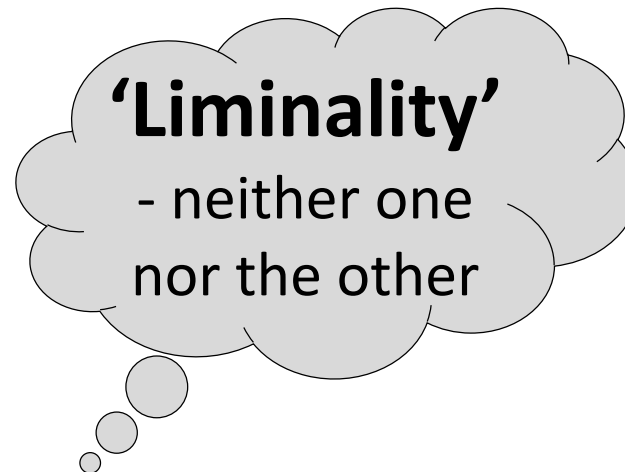
# 'Rite of passage'

# Wilderness – a place of testing

16.4 - Then the Lord said to Moses, 'I am going to rain bread from heaven for you, and each day the people shall go out and gather enough for that day. In that way **I will test them**, whether they will follow my instruction or not.'

# Manna - three areas of testing

- 1. Gather it each day – don't try to keep it.**
- 2. Gather twice as much on Friday, ready for Sabbath.**
- 3. Don't gather any on Sabbath.**

*The Israelites did so, some gathering more, some less. But when they measured it with an omer, those who gathered much had nothing over, and those who gathered little had no shortage; they gathered as much as each of them needed.*

*And Moses said to them, 'Let no one leave any of it over until morning.' But they did not listen to Moses; some left part of it until morning, and it bred worms and became foul. And Moses was angry with them.*

*Morning by morning they gathered it, as much as each needed; but when the sun grew hot, it melted.*

*On the sixth day they gathered twice as much food, two omers apiece.*

*[...]*

*On the seventh day some of the people went out to gather, and they found none. The Lord said to Moses, 'How long will you refuse to keep my commandments and instructions? See! The Lord has given you the sabbath, therefore on the sixth day he gives you food for two days; each of you stay where you are; do not leave your place on the seventh day.' So the people rested on the seventh day.*
